Weplay Balance Arch Instructions

A. 1/4 Circle Assembly



1. Place the yellow rods into the hexagon shapes holes on the ¼ circle plank as shown.



2. Place the second ¼ circle plank of top of the yellow rods, carefully fitting them into the hexagon shaped holes.



3. Using the wrench, secure the rods to the planks on both sides with the large plastic yellow nuts.



4. ¼ Circle Assembly completed.

B. ½ Circle Assembly



 Use the butterfly shaped connector with screws attached to connect two ¼ planks, as shown.



2. Carefully turn the two ¼ circle planks over, taking care not to dislodge the butterfly shaped connector. Fit a butterfly shaped connector without bolts attached into the open space, as shown.



3. Place the small green nuts into the openings on the butterfly shaped connector and tighten, using the wrench.



4. Follow ¼ Circle Assembly instructions above to attach the yellow rods and complete the ½ Circle Assembly.

C. Whole Circle Assembly



1. Follow the ½ Circle
Assembly instructions
above to make two ½
circle planks. You will
now have a complete
circle.



2. Place the yellow rods into the hexagon shaped holes on the Circle as shown.



3. Carefully place the second complete Circle on top of the yellow rods, fitting the rods into the hexagon shaped holes. Using the wrench, secure the rods to the circular plank with the large plastic yellow nuts.



4. Turn the circle over and, using the remaining large plastic yellow nuts, secure the rods to the Circle with the wrench. The Whole Circle is then complete.
